We agree with you and Noise011--the current level of 95 decibels is excessive. The Green Party will support all measures to reduce this level to the 90 decibel level you recommend. Non-compliant vehicle owners have now had generous warning from the Government that stricter measures were likely to follow, so now is the time to act on this policy change.
